Story Building

The youngest player should pick out four things they can see outside the window.

Once you have the objects, the game can begin. Each player takes it in turns to add to a story that builds a little bit at a time. The first player must include the first of the four objects, the second includes the second thing and this goes on to use all four objects. You could keep adding more groups of four things until you have a never ending story! — or at least, until one of the players gets it wrong! Then, they must drop out of the game.

Here is an example:
